NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Budget Committee of South Central Public Health District will meet on Wednesday, May 21, 2014, at 1:30 P.M. in the Katz Conference Room (north entrance), South Central Public Health District, 1020 Washington Street North, Twin Falls, Idaho, for the purpose of considering and fixing a final budget of \$6,333,918 for South Central Public Health District for the period beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015. At this time, any taxpayer may appear and be heard upon any part of the budget. Written statements may be mailed to Ms. Linda F. Montgomery, Chair of the District Board of Health, 1020 Washington St. North, Twin Falls, Idaho, 83301-3156, and said written statements will be read into the minutes of the meeting.
