SCPHD Dental Clinic for Children Offered in Blaine County

TWIN FALLS-Dr. Dallin Young is providing dental services for children ages 0-17, by appointment only, at South Central Public Health District (SCPHD) in Bellevue. The clinics are held on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month from 8:30 a.m.- 5 p.m, and include exams, x-rays, and fluoride varnish. Most dental insurances, including Medicaid and Idaho Smiles, will be accepted.

Children are encouraged to see a dentist six months after the first tooth erupts, or by their first year of age. Dr. Young is a pediatric dentist and specializes in working with and treating children.

If a child is found to have cavities, they will not be filled at this clinic. Dr. Young will evaluate the best way to fix the cavities and schedule a follow-up appointment at his office in Twin Falls, at St. Luke's Wood River, or at another dentist's office by referral.

Appointments are necessary for these clinics and can be scheduled by calling 788-4335. The Blaine County SCPHD office is located at 117 East Ash Street in Bellevue.
