**SCPHD Reminds Blaine County Residents That the Bellevue Office Is Still Open For Business**

TWIN FALLS – Last week, South Central Public Health District (SCPHD) announced the end of its family planning program in Bellevue, Burley, and Jerome. SCPHD has received several calls from the public in reference to the entire Bellevue office being closed. SCPHD wants to reassure the Blaine County community that the Bellevue office is still open. All other services and programs provided by the SCPHD Bellevue office (including immunizations, Environmental Health services, and WIC) are still available from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

“Unfortunately, we had to end our family planning program in all of our offices, but that is only a small portion of what we do as an agency. All five of our offices remain open and ready to service the communities of south central Idaho,” says Rene LeBlanc, SCPHD District Health Director.
