

Registered Nurse (RN)/License Practical Nurse (LPN):

This position is considered temporary and is not eligible for benefits. The incumbent will work no more than 19 hours per week, but must commit to being available for at least 8 hours per week. The position will end when there is no longer a high demand for Flu and/or COVID-19 vaccine clinics.

Employees in this position will provide public health nursing services, including Flu and COVID-19 vaccines at both internal and external clinics. Working within established policies, the incumbent will plan and conduct professional nursing services using independent judgment and evaluation.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

Plan, coordinate, and execute COVID-19 and Flu immunization clinics
Provide in-office immunization clinics.
Provide public health related education to local community partners and stakeholders.
Participate in the investigation and mitigation of infectious diseases (including STDs).
Provide outreach or clinics during irregular hours, including evening and weekends.
Travel to other counties within the Health District to provide all of the above services
Incumbents provide nursing services in homes, rural areas, clinical settings, and nursing facilities.

This position requires independent clinical judgment. Patients may vary in socioeconomic, cultural, emotional, and/or physical needs and may be confused, disoriented, aggressive or hostile. Some settings may involve exposure to communicable diseases, lifting and moving patients or equipment weighing up to 50-pounds.

MINIMUM (REQUIRED) QUALIFICATIONS:

Licensed as a Practical or Registered Nurse in Idaho as defined by Idaho Code 54-1408 or state licensure as a Registered Nurse pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact, Idaho Code 54-1418, in one of the following compact states: Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Iowa, Kentucky, Maine, Maryland, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, or Wisconsin.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Experience questioning customers to obtain detailed information in a business setting
Experience administering vaccines
Experience documenting in an electronic medical record
Experience working independently in clinical settings
Ability to travel throughout the District and provide clinics during various hours, including weekend

PREFERED QUALIFICATIONS:

Fluent in speaking, reading and/or writing Spanish

Ability to perform multiple tasks simultaneously while dealing with continual interruptions

Experience in Microsoft Office products
