

## **Part time temporary Health Educator**

South Central Public Health District is looking for a part time health educator to teach teens and adults about the dangers of smoking and vaping, and to teach cessation classes to people who are smoking and vaping.

This is a part time, temporary position and does not qualify for benefits. Pay is hourly. This position is not compatible with telecommuting or remote work. Hours will be flexible, and may not necessarily be a fixed amount each week. Hours depend on available funding and the work that needs to be done. Occasionally, work must be done during the evening or on a Saturday.

The salary is \$20/hour.

Responsibilities:

- Teaching classes to help teens quit vaping or smoking (at schools, juvenile detention, the public health office, etc.)
- Teaching five-week classes to adults who are wanting to quit smoking or vaping
- Teaching pregnant women how to quit smoking
- Teaching tobacco prevention at health classes and assemblies at local schools
- Assisting with events (health fairs, school sporting events, etc.) to provide tobacco prevention education

Qualifications:

- Degree in health or education field (public health, RN, LPN, health sciences, school health, teaching certificate) or equivalent experience. Current college students in these fields of study will be considered.
- Experience teaching in various situations: one-on-one, small and large groups, online, etc.
- Excellent public speaking skills
- Ability to learn new content quickly
- Proficiency with computers, projectors, and other common modes of technology
- Ability to exhibit a professional, positive attitude and work ethic
- Ability to be at work on time and follow through on teaching commitments
