Upcoming Solar Eclipse Workshop in Twin Falls County

TWIN FALLS- Regional first responders, community leaders, public information officers, and emergency personnel have been invited to participate with South Central Public Health District (SCPHD) in the workshop "It's a Total Solar Eclipse of the Heart." The workshop will include discussion and preparation for the upcoming Solar Eclipse.
